## THE ITALIAN TOP SCIENTIST 2011 AWARD

The award of "Top Scientist 2011" has been presented during the "Food Science Gran Gala" held in Milan during December 2011. The event was organized with the sponsorship of 12 Italian journals from the agro-food sectors and in celebration of the 55th anniversary of the INTERNATIONAL P.B.I. foundation.

Several scientists and technologists involved in innovation and development for the food and dairy industries were present to congratulate the Top Scientist 2011 and other colleagues receiving awards.

### The Top Scientist 2011 Award

The Top Scientist 2011 award was presented to Sebastiano Porretta in acknowledgement of his contribution as "a reliable reference for science, food technology and its disclosure". Sebastiano Porretta is responsible for the Consumer Science Department at the "Stazione Sperimentale per l'Industria delle Conserve Alimentari" (SSICA) in Parma and is also a Professor at the "Sacro Cuore" Catholic University and President of the Italian Society for Food Technology (AITA). He is very well known in the international scientific community for his work and is the author of several papers for international magazines plus more than 20 specialized books in both Italian and English.
